It is designed for you to become an informed and astute investor using the listen-as-you-learn radio drama and workbook with guided discussion format.

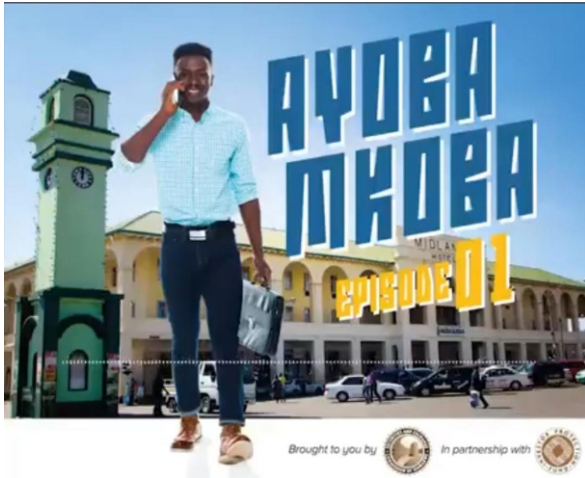
Instructions
